







Median Sales Price vs. Sales Volume




Median Listing Price vs. Listing Volume






Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold




Number of Bedrooms in Homes Sold






Population of Children by Age Group




Population of Adults by Age Group












How People Get to Work

The experience around other students is another story. Many students were outwardly racist or held nazi ideologies and were not shy about it. Bullying was incredibly common, but if you kept quiet you could typically avoid too much of it. Many students are also very kind and friendly, it really depends on who you get involved with. Also a decent amount of drug use, almost always encountered girls vaping in the bathrooms when I just needed to pee. Cherokee was always dirty and often you would see cockroaches or mice, not by any fault of the janitors. Mostly the fault of students not respecting the environment around them.
