

GEORGIA HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION

D O N ' T M I S S O U T !

If you bought a home in Georgia last year and it's your primary residence, you may qualify for the Homestead Exemption. This tax benefit can lower your property taxes—but you must apply!

January 1st

You must own and occupy your home as of January 1st of this year.

Apply

Apply in the county where the home is located.

Deadline is April 1st

Deadline is usually April 1st, but check your county for exact dates.



Renews Automatically

Once granted, the exemption renews automatically each year

Cobb County

Apply online, mail the application in, or drop off at one of the Property Tax Office locations

Bartow County

Apply in person at the Tax Assessors Office 135 W Cherokee Ave # 217A, Cartersville, GA 30120

Paulding County
