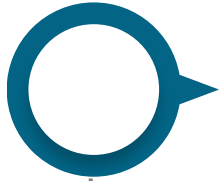

Visit the Cherokee County Board of Tax Assessors site for information and the real property appeal form



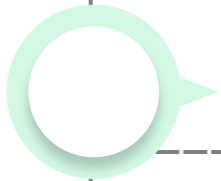
Receive Notice of Assessment

45 calendar days from the mailing date to file an appeal with the Cherokee County Board of Tax Assessors



File Your Written Appeal

Submit a written appeal to the Board of Assessor



Board of Assessors Reviews your Appeal

If they adjust the value, you'll receive a new written notice with an additional 30 days to appeal that decision



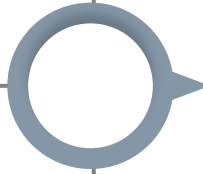
New Value Received



If you're happy with the value, then the process is complete

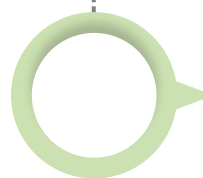


If not, you'll have the opportunity to file an appeal with the Board of Equalization



Hearing

Appeal moves to the County Board of Equalization. A new written value assessment is issued



If you're still dissatisfied after the hearing, you can file an appeal with the Superior Court. It then becomes a legal case



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
