One must apply for a Georgia driver's license within 30 days of becoming a Georgia resident. All Customer Service Centers can transfer an out of state license to a Georgia license. A few Customer Service Centers in the Metro Atlanta area (Atlanta-Capital Ave, Decatur, Lithonia, Locust Grove, North Cobb and Lawrenceville) offer appointments to transfer an out of state license to Georgia. The Georgia Department of Driver Services issues driver's licenses for all residents of the state.

Tags

A new resident moving to Georgia needs to register or renew a motor vehicle application. The applicant must provide a photo ID, proof of insurance and a current emissions certificate (when applicable). Renewal must be done by the applicant's birthday. If a new resident to Georgia moves into the state after his/her birthday, proof must be provided in order to be exempt from taxes for the current year.

PROPERTY TAXES

All property owners in the City of Sandy Springs pay property taxes to Fulton County, the Fulton County School System and the City of Sandy Springs. Property tax bills will continue to come from the Fulton County Tax Commissioner's Office.

Homestead Exemption—To qualify for a homestead exemption, you must own and occupy the property as your legal residence as of January 1 of the current tax year. There is no deadline to apply, however, to receive the exemption for the current year, applications must be filed by March 1. Applications filed after March 1 will be considered for the following year. For additional information on eligibility or the proper method of applying for an exemption, you may call the Tax Assessors' Office at (404) 224-0102.
