HISTORIC SITES

- **Barrington Hall:** Step back in time at Barrington Hall, a historic home built in the Greek Revival style. Take a guided tour of the mansion, stroll through the gardens, and learn about Roswell's antebellum past.
- **Roswell Mill Ruins:** Discover the remnants of Roswell's industrial heritage at the Roswell Mill Ruins. Explore the scenic walking trails along Vickery Creek, admire the historic mill buildings, and marvel at the picturesque waterfalls.
